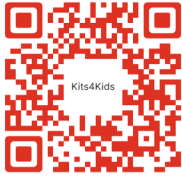

Kid Spokesperson Campaign **"Kits4Kids Ambassadors: Little Voices! Big Impact!"**



This campaign is in the planning stages and a committee has been formed to put the campaign together. We are looking for volunteers for this committee and others that we are just forming. Our Kits4Kids were just introduced for the first time in July with overwhelming response. People all want to do something about the plight of our kids today.

The vision is that this is a grassroots community-based campaign in search of kids that want to be the spokesperson in their community for the Kits4Kids Initiative. The goal of the initiative is to put a safety go-kit in kid's everyday backpack that goes wherever they go. A boy and girl, ages 7-18 will represent their community in regard to the activities around the Initiative. They will submit a 1 minute video about why they want to be the spokes-kids. The community leaders will vote on the submissions. Then the kids from the different communities will vote on who will represent their state and who will be the national spokespeople.

Nationally kids are making their voices heard when it comes to their safety, the planet and their futures. Forty-three percent of the population is Millennials and GenZs'. They are concerned and now they have children that 76% of them are worried about their fears, anxiety and depression. As a great-grandparent I think about what this work is going to be like for my 8-year old great-grandson.

Local Realtors and other Professionals will work with community leaders, parents, teachers, other kid's organizations that in turn will be a great way to build relationships while protecting kids. There are now kids taking states to court. The first one was in Montana where 15 kids, ages 5 to 22 sued the state because they were not tracking how much greenhouse gas was being produced in the State and they WON! In 2024 there are several states following suit.
